### Covid-19 Plan - Easing of Restrictions Stage 3

Western Downs Regional Council remains committed to providing a safe environment in which to conduct its weekly cattle sale, with the following measures in place to ensure the Saleyards can continue its vital service to the nation's food supply chain.

From: 12pm (midday) 3 July 2020

- Only one entry point to the site
- General Public will be allowed access to the saleyards
- A declaration form must be completed and signed prior to entry
- Declaration forms can be kept on file to save completing each week in full
- If declaration forms are kept on file, a record of attendance each week will be checked off on entry following verbal confirmation that the attendee:
  1. Has had no close contact with someone who has travelled internationally in the last 14 days
  2. Has no flu like symptoms within the previous 72 hours
  3. Is not feeling unwell now
- Hand sanitising stations will be available
- Physical distancing of 1.5 metres between persons applies in public areas
- Increased cleaning and disinfection of surfaces in frequent use
- PPE will be provided for staff
- PPE will be available on request for other attendees
- Canteen operations will continue as per canteen operator's Covidsafe plan
- If attendees are not participating in an auction, they will be asked to keep the buyer's walkway clear, with other participants able to observe from another walkway
